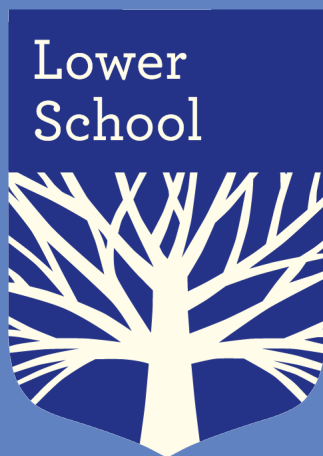


Kindergarten
